For immediate relief/immediate needs & to claim evacuee or displacement status, contact the American Red Cross and register into their evacuee system by calling **1-800- GET-INFO (438-4636)**. Their website is www.redcross.org.

(The TTY Number for the hearing impaired is 1-800-462-7585). You will receive a FEMA Control Number. Make sure that you keep this number close at hand. This is your introduction into the federal relief process.
