FIC BORCHARDT

The year is 350AD and while Roman forces sweep across barbarian lands, a battle of another kind culminates when a rogue werewolf named Manael is confronted by Dryas, a Druid priestess bent on destroying him and the rest of his kind. Borchardt (Anne Rice's sister) wrote this prequel to accompany her first werewolf novel The Silver Wolf (FIC BORCHARDT), a story in which a fledgling female werewolf named Reagan fights to preserve her heritage during Europe's Dark Ages.

High Bloods / by John Farris FIC FARRIS

With LA in the near-future steadily succumbing to a werewolf epidemic, humans have formed the Lycan Control to prevent the werewolves, humans 28 days out of the month but ravenous under a full moon", from further carnage and destruction.

Nadya: The Wolf Chronicles / by Pat Murphy

FIC MURPHY

Exiled from her native Poland, Nadya Rybak must navigate the nineteenth century American frontier utilizing her lupine heritage (she's a werewolf) to the fullest extent.

FIC PEKEARO

Doomed to always be a werewolf due to a family blood curse, middle-aged drifter Marlowe Higgins has learned to use his lycan powers to help police catch (and punish) criminals.
