



Prehistory:

- Bosse Cave Beyond Time
A recently orphaned boy journeys from the site of an archeological dig to three different eras of ancient times.
- Brooke A Is For Aarrgh!
Mog, a Stone Age boy, discovers words and language and teaches other cave dwellers how to talk, altering history.
- Denzel Boy of the Painted Cave
A prehistoric age boy yearns to be a cave painter.
- Denzel Land of the Thundering Herds
This chronicles the activities and adventures of prehistoric animals on a grassland.
- Garcia Spirit on the Wall
Mat-Maw defies clan customs in order to allow her handicapped granddaughter to develop her artistic gifts.
- Griffin 11,000 Years Lost
An eleven year old Texas girl goes back in time to the Pleistocene era.
- McGowen The Time of the Forest
When war breaks out between their opposing sides in ancient Denmark, Bright Fawn of the farming community and Wolf of the hunters' tribe flee from the forest and take refuge in the forest.
- Millstead Cave of Moving Shadows
A Cro-Magnon boy must choose between his training in sorcery and his desire to be a hunter.
- Pryor Seth of the Lion People
A boy with a twisted leg is tolerated for his storytelling talent and he senses that hunters will soon transition into artisans and farmers and he seeks to be their leader.
- Turnbull Maroo of the Winter Caves
Maroo must take charge after her father is killed and lead her family to safety before winter comes.



Ancient Civilizations:

- Alcock Singer to the Sea God (Greece)
When he and his companions flee their island home after the king's court is turned to stone, Phaidon begins to believe in the gods and monsters his uncle has always scorned.
- Benchley Demo and the Dolphin (Greece)
A dolphin takes Demo back through time to ask the oracle at Delphi how he can help his father become a successful fisherman.
- Bradshaw Beyond the North Wind (Greece)
The Greek god Apollo sends a young magician on a quest to stop an evil queen from exterminating a tribe of griffins.
- PatonWalsh Children of the Fox (Greece)
These are three novellas that depict three young people who do not know each other, but are linked in devotion to the Greek General Themistokles.
- Speare The Bronze Bow (Galilee/Roman)
Daniel, a young Jewish rebel, is drawn to the Rabbi Jesus in the earliest days of Christianity.
- Sutcliff Sun Horse, Moon Horse (ancient Britons)
A boy in pre-Roman Britain becomes chieftain of his tribe and learns of sacrifice.

- Winterfeld Detectives in Togas (Rome)
Trying to save a boy wrongly accused, young friends in ancient Rome search for the culprit who scrawled on the temple wall.
- Yarbro Four Horses for Tishtry (Rome)
Tishtry's wish to buy her family's freedom from slavery in the Roman Empire, inspires her to perform dangerous feats of stunt riding.



Ancient Egypt:

- Bunting I Am The Mummy Heb-Nefert
Mummy recalls her past life in ancient Egypt and the beautiful wife of the Pharaoh's brother.
- Carter His Majesty, Queen Hatshepsut
This is a fictionalized account of Hatshepsut, a queen in ancient Egypt, who declared herself king & ruled as king for over twenty years.
- Ellerby King Tut's Game Board
While vacationing in Egypt, Justin makes discoveries about two ancient civilizations.
- Gregory Cleopatra: Daughter of the Nile
A young Cleopatra records in her diary her hopes and fears about becoming Queen in the future.
- Lattimore The Winged Cat
In ancient Egypt, a young girl and a High Priest must find magic spells to open the twelve gates of the Netherworld to determine the truth about the death of a sacred cat.
- Lester Pharaoh's Daughter
This is a fictionalized account of the Biblical story about the Egyptian princess who rescues a Hebrew infant who becomes a prophet.
- Levitin Escape From Egypt
When Moses comes to lead the Israelites to the Promised Land, Jesse, a Hebrew slave finds his life changed by his growing faith in God and his attraction to the half-Egyptian, half-Syrian Jennat.
- Logan The 5,000 Year-Old-Puzzle
This is a fictional account of the excavation of a secret tomb at Giza.
- Reig Diary of the Boy King, Tut-Ankh-Amen
This is a fictionalized account of King Tut.
- Rubalcaba A Place in the Sun
In ancient Egypt, the gifted son of a sculptor is enslaved and almost killed after trying to save his father's life until he is awarded the title of Royal Sculptor.
- Rubalcaba The Wadjet Eye
After his mother dies, Damon, a medical student in ancient Egypt, makes a trip to Spain to locate his father who is serving in the Roman army under Julius Caesar.
