Adler ***Mama Played Baseball*** **E Adler**
Young Amy helps her mother to get a job as a player in the All-American Girls Professional Baseball League while Amy's father is serving in the Army during World War II.

Corey ***Players In Pigtails*** **E Corey**
Katie Casey, a fictional character, helps start the All-American Girls Professional Baseball League, which gave women the opportunity to play professional baseball while America was involved in World War II.

Deedy ***The Yellow Star*** **E Deedy**
Retells the story of King Christian X and the Danish resistance to the Nazis during World War II.

Fleming ***Boxes For Katje*** **E Fleming**
After a young Dutch girl writes to her new American friend in thanks for the care package sent after World War II, she begins to receive increasingly larger boxes.

Mochizuki ***Baseball Saved Us*** **E Mochizuk**
A Japanese American boy learns to play baseball when he and his family are forced to live in an internment camp during World War II, and his ability to play helps him after the war is over.

Rappaport ***Dirt On Their Skirts*** **E Rappapor**
Margaret experiences the excitement of watching the 1946 championship game of the All-American Girls Professional Baseball League as it goes into extra innings.

Chapter Books:

Borden ***The Greatest Skating Race*** **J Fic Borden**
During World War II in the Netherlands, a ten-year-old boy's dream of skating in a famous race allows him to help two children escape to Belgium by ice skating past German soldiers and other enemies.

Giff ***Willow Run*** **J Fic Giff**
During World War II, after moving with her parents to Willow Run, Michigan, when her father gets a job in the B-24 bomber-building factory, eleven-year-old Meggie learns about different kinds of bravery from all of the people around her.

Gwaltney ***Homefront*** **J Fic Gwaltney**
When her British aunt and cousin flee London during World War II and come to live in her family's farmhouse in Virginia, Margaret Ann is unhappy with having to share a room and having her life disrupted by a relative she hardly knows.

Hart ***A Spy On The Home Front*** **J Mys Hart**
During a visit to her grandparents' Illinois farm in 1944, ten-year-old Molly tries to prove the innocence of a German-American neighbor whom the FBI suspects of smuggling anti-American propaganda.

McDonough ***The Doll With The Yellow Star*** **J Fic Donnoug**
When France falls to Germany at the start of World War II, nine-year-old Claudine must leave her beloved parents and friends to stay with relatives in America, accompanied by her doll, Violette.

Tripp ***Meet Molly: An American Girl*** **J Fic Tripp**
While her father is away fighting in World War II, Molly finds her life full of change as she eats terrible vegetables from the victory garden and plans revenge on her brother for ruining her Halloween.
