Personalities:

Bolden, Tonya *The Champ* (Muhammad Ali) **J B Ali**
 Story of the great boxer who “floated like a butterfly, and stung like a bee.”

Carroll, Jillian *Aretha Franklin* **J B Franklin**
 Story of the “Queen of Soul”

Glassman, Bruce *Mikhail Baryshnikov* **J B Baryshnikov**
 Story of the brilliant ballet dancer who went on to become a choreographer, actor, and director of the American Ballet Theatre.

Gordon, Matthew *Khomeini* **J B Khomeini**
 The story of Ayatollah Khomeini, the leader of Iran’s Islamic Revolution.

Jeffery, Laura S. *Barbara Jordan* **J B Jordan**
 In 1972, she became the first African-American woman from the South to be elected to the United States Congress.

Lazo, Caroline *Mother Teresa* **J B Teresa**
 Biography of the nun who founded the Missionaries of Charity, gained recognition for her work with the destitute and dying in Calcutta and was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1979.

Moutoussamy-Ashe, Jeanne *Daddy and Me* (Arthur Ashe) **J B Ashe**
 The story of tennis champion Arthur Ashe and his relationship with his daughter Camera, that thrived in the face of AIDS.

Rau, Dana M. *George Lucas* **J B Lucas**
 Biography of the creator of Star Wars.

Ryan, Bernard *Jimmy Carter* **J B Carter**
 Jimmy Carter rose from peanut farmer, to President, to peacemaker, humanitarian and Nobel Laureate.

Schuman *Richard M. Nixon* **J B Nixon**
 Traces the life of the 37th president, from childhood, presidency, the Watergate scandal, and his role as an elder statesman.

Fun Stuff Trivia:
