E Buzzeo **The Sea Chest**

A young girl listens as her great-aunt, a lighthouse keeper's daughter, tells of her childhood living on a Maine island, and of the infant that washed ashore after a storm

E Olson **The Lighthouse Keeper's Daughter**

When her father's return to a Maine lighthouse is delayed by a severe storm, Miranda must keep the light going despite brutal weather and her own illness

ER Roop **Keep the Lights Burning, Abbie**

In the winter of 1856, a storm delays the lighthouse keeper's return to an island off the coast of Maine, and his daughter Abbie must keep the lights burning by herself

E Stainton **The Lighthouse Cat**

When a fishing boat is caught in a storm, a lighthouse cat named Little Mackerel gathers other cats to try to help out

E Swift **The Little Red Lighthouse And The Great Gray Bridge**

A little lighthouse on the Hudson River regains its pride when it finds out that it is still useful and has an important job to do

E Vaughan **Abbie Against The Storm**

A fictionalized account of an incident in the life of a fourteen year old girl who tends her family's lighthouse during a fierce storm on the coast of Maine in the winter of 1856

Searching For Juvenile Fiction:

Fletcher **Walk Across The Sea**

In late nineteenth century California, when Chinese immigrants are being driven out or even killed for fear they will take jobs from whites, Eliza Jane McCully defies the townspeople and her lighthouse-keeper father to help a Chinese boy who has been kind to her

Hesse **A Light In The Storm**

In 1860 and 1861, while working in her father's lighthouse on an island off the coast of Delaware, Amelia records in her diary how the Civil War is beginning to devastate her divided state

Hopkinson **Birdie's Lighthouse**

The diary of a ten year old girl who moves with her family in 1855 from a town on the Maine coast to rugged Turtle Island where her father is to be the lighthouse keeper

Kinsey-Warnock **Gifts From The Sea**

Quila and her father live alone in a lighthouse and they find their lives profoundly changed when a baby washes ashore and they decide to keep her as one of their family

Minahan **Abigail's Drum**

During the War of 1812, when British soldiers threaten the town of Scituate, Massachusetts, young Rebecca Bates and her sister Abigail, daughters of the local lighthouse keeper, find a way to save both him and the town

Pfitsch **Keeper Of the Light**

After her father's death in 1872, Faith takes over his job as lighthouse keeper on Lake Superior, until her mother decides to move into town, where Faith finds herself stifled by the role society expects her to play

Prior **Lily Quench and the Lighthouse of Skellig Mor**

Lily Quench and her friend Dragon Queen visit a group of mysterious islands where they befriend a lighthouse keeper and find a clue in a book with magical properties
