## Ladybug Puppet

### You Need:

- Two red cake paper plates
- Scissors (have adult help you, if needed)
- Tape (staple optional)
- Black marker
- Black construction paper
- Pipe cleaner
- Hole punch
- Googly eyes (optional)



- Use black construction paper to cut out two sets of three legs
- Tape two paper plates together with eating side of plates on inside.
- Tape the legs between the plates and don't tape the plates all the way around. Leave one end open—untaped.
- Cut off rim of plates where not taped. You will put your hand in here to move puppet.
- With black marker, draw some black dots on ladybug or glue some black circles on its back. Draw eyes or glue googly eyes.
- Punch two holes on top for antennae. Place a pipe cleaner through the holes. Now make up your own ladybug puppet play. Have fun!!
