When she and all of the other guests, including her sisters, arrive at the party donned in Faerie regalia, she’s plunged back in time to the 13<sup>th</sup> century. There a man named Montgomery de Piaget, the official Lord of the original castle, thinks the girls really are fairies and it’s up to Pippa to tell him otherwise. This book is a part of Kurland’s “Di Piaget” time travel series. (FIC KURLAND) *SUBTLE*

**With Every Breath** / by Lynn Kurland

Medieval Scottish Laird Robert Cameron knows his brother is gravely ill. So he embarks on an outing to find the witch Moraig, known to have healing powers but also a woman living in enemy territory—land belonging to the rival MacLeods. Robert arrives at the witch’s hut only to find that the person living their isn’t Moraig but a strangely dressed woman from another century calling herself Sunny. This book is a part of Kurland’s “MacLeod” time travel series. (FIC KURLAND) *SUBTLE*

**The Best Gift** / by Wendy Markham

At present Clara McCallum is happily married to Drew Becker, the reincarnation of a WWII soldier she fell in love with when she traveled back in time to the year 1941. But one Christmas morning, an earthquake hits near the pair’s California home and suddenly Clara is again transported, forward this time, to the year 2012 where she emerges alone and eight months pregnant. **Touch of Enchantment** / by Teresa Medeiros

Tabitha Lennox has always considered herself more rational than most. But when she looks closer at a strange amulet which her mother bequeathed to her, she’s suddenly hurled back in time to the fourteenth century and directly into the path of a chain-mailed knight on horseback.
