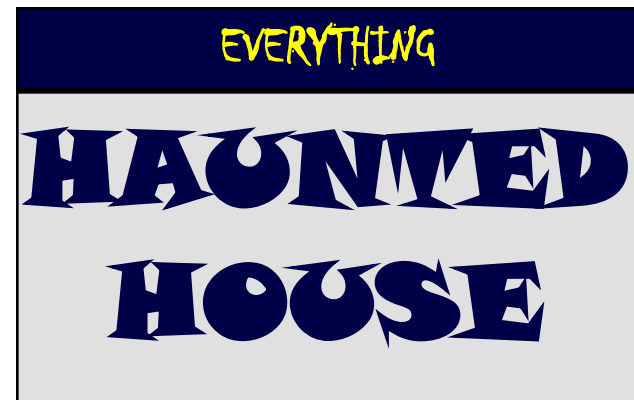

NOVELS

The Bell Witch: An American Haunting: Being the Eye Witness Account of Richard Powell Concerning the Bell Witch Haunting of Robertson County, Tennessee 1817-1821 / Brent Monahan, ed.

A man follows the lives of those haunted by a mysterious presence within the home of the Bell Family in Tennessee as the fictional narrator by a witness to the horror. (FIC BELL)

The Diary of Ellen Rimbauer: My Life At Rose Red / Joyce Reardon, ed.

In the early part of the twentieth century, oil baron John Rimbauer and his wife Ellen build an enormous mansion in Seattle against the wishes of locals who say building the home on an Indian burial ground is a bad omen. Tragedy follows in the lives of those who live inside the house as testified to by Ellen herself in her diary. (FIC DIARY)

The Good House: A Novel / by Tananarive Due

In a small town in Washington state, the Toussaint home still feels the haunting effects from over a century ago when a powerful voodoo priestess from New Orleans unleashed a horrible spirit over it. Now, years later the woman's descendants have come to the home to help rid the house and the town of its deadly curse. (FIC DUE)

Ghost Moon / by Heather Graham

When reclusive Key West collector Cutter Merlin dies under mysterious circumstances, his granddaughter Kelsey visits his home to organize his things only to find herself in the grip of an otherworldly presence and one particularly terrifying object. (FIC GRAHAM)

The Woman in Black / by Susan Hill

Young solicitor Arthur Kipps is summoned to the small English village of Crythin Gifford to organize the estate of the now deceased Alice Drablow only to be received with suspicion and coldness by the townspeople. At the former home of the old woman, Arthur is recurrently confronted by the ghastly apparition of a veiled woman dressed in black. (FIC HILL)

The Haunting of Hill House / by Shirley Jackson

Four strangers arrive at the purportedly haunted Hill House to investigate the psychic phenomenon which may be tied to the house's dreadful history. (FIC JACKSON)

Bag of Bones / by Stephen King

The sudden death of his wife has given famed novelist Mick Noonan both grief and writer's block. When he decides to relocate to the couple's Maine vacation home, a place his wife mysteriously visited before her death, he uncovers more than a few buried secrets and is soon haunted by an ominous presence within the home itself. (FIC KING)

The Shining / by Stephen King

The new caretaker at the Overlook Hotel and his family are soon terrorized by the spirits of the past during their isolated stay. Now their only hope of survival may be their young son Danny, a clairvoyant. (FIC KING)

Audrey's Door / by Sarah Langan

An archaic building in Manhattan's Upper West Side houses an astonishingly low priced apartment. Due to a recent tragedy, no one will even go near it until Audrey Lucas promptly buys it up and is immediately haunted by a presence which begs her to build a door in the bedroom wall. (FIC LANGAN)

The Cellar / by Richard Laymon

In the town of Malcasa Point, CA is a haunted house known as the Beast House. Though off limits at night, daytime tours are conducted which take visitors through every room but the cellar to which no one, not even the tour guides, dare venture. This is Laymon's first installment of the *Beast House* chronicles which includes **The Beast House**, **The Midnight Tour** & **Friday Night in the Beast House**. (FIC LAYMON)

Gad's Hall / by Norah Lofts

Gad's Hall, an English country home on the market for the first time in over a century, is purchased by a couple and their three children who are desperate for home with enough space to suit their needs. But when their daughter Jill finds herself experiencing strange sensations in certain parts of the house, particularly the empty locked room upstairs, the dream becomes a nightmare. The sequel to this book (actually a prequel) is **The Haunting of Gad's Hall**. (FIC LOFTS)

The House The Jack Built / by Graham Masterton

A man and his wife purchase a crumbling mansion in upstate New York and discover to their surprise and ultimate horror that the house has an eerie energy all its own. (FIC MASTERTON)

Hell House / by Richard Matheson

Four people will be given a million dollars if they can survive one night in Belasco House, one of the most famous haunted houses of all time. (FIC MATHESON)

In the Dark of the Night: A Novel / by John Saul

A family of four from Chicago buys a vacation home for the summer only to discover the horrific way in which the previous owner lived and ultimately died. The revelation causes the children to delve deeper into the house's haunted past. (FIC SAUL)

The House Next Door / by Anne Rivers Siddons

A newly built home in suburban Atlanta is plagued by mysterious accidents and unnatural occurrences as the first and then the second family living there soon find out. (FIC SIDDONS)

The Ghost and the Haunted Mansion / by Alice Kimberly

When a local man inherits a haunted mansion and decides to exorcise the ghost known to be present there, bookshop owner Pen must act fast to preserve the house's mysterious but friendly presence. (MYS KIMBERLY)

A wife waits for her long dead husband inside the house where he died; a young lodger finds he's not the only presence in his room at night; a family discovers the real reason for their neighbors' horror; and, a young man's fiancé is haunted by a terrifying ghost at a vacation home in the South of France. "The Fall of the House of Usher" by Edgar Allan Poe

A man visits his friend Roderick Usher and his sister inside an ancient, crumbling mansion which bears evidence of being unusually sensitive to its inhabitants moods and behaviors. Later when Mr. Usher's sister dies and is buried, the house and its surroundings become even more ghastly and surreal. Found In: **The Fall of the House of Usher and Other Tales** / by Edgar Allan Poe (FIC POE)
