## **EMERGENCY PREP & DISASTER EVACUATION**

It is important to have a plan in order to keep safe in the event of an emergency. The most visible and actively used format for preparedness is with a basic emergency plan which entails three steps: 1) Get a Kit 2) Make a Plan, 3) Stay Informed. This plan coordinates the emergency management in the event of a hurricane or other occurrence. The plan is advocated by the city, county and state governments as well as authorities at the federal level. Various plans and checklists are listed on the web at these locations.

### **For disaster relief & evacuee assistance, what do I do first?**

For immediate relief/immediate needs & to claim evacuee or displacement status: Contact the American Red Cross and register into their evacuee system by calling **1-800-GET-INFO (438-4636)**. For Federal Assistance:

(The TTY Number for the hearing impaired is 1-800-462-7585). You will receive a FEMA Control Number. Make sure that you keep this number close at hand. This is your introduction into the federal relief process.
