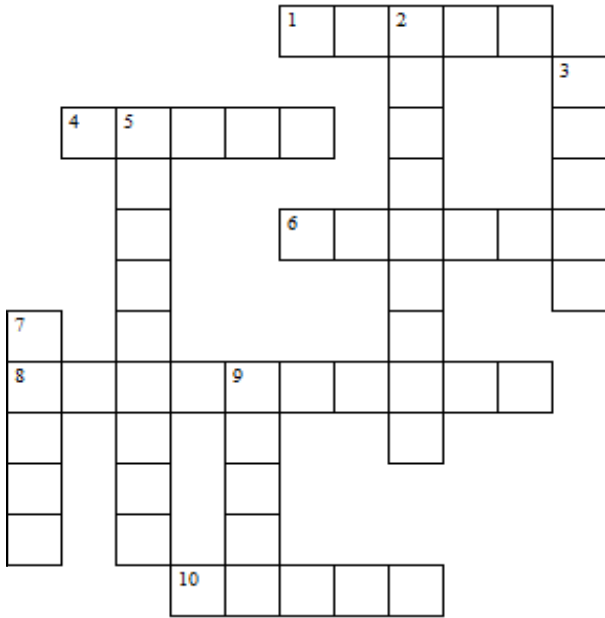


Music Crossword

- 7** A stringed instrument that works when someone presses the keys and a hammer strikes the strings to make the sound.
