Some Dinosaur Activities:

- * Make some dinosaur fossils using playdough or other dough-like material. You can make the fossil by pushing a little dinosaur figure into the dough. You can also bury some dinosaurs in some sand or a sandbox and have you child use a little paint brush and shovel to find the dinosaurs (a small excavation).
- * Pretend to be different kinds of dinosaurs with your child. Discuss how the dinosaur would walk, what does the dinosaur have (spines on the stegosaurus, horns on the triceratops) and what these were for.
- * Do a dinosaur dance with different dinosaur footprints.
