### Some "Being Thankful" Activities:

\* Discuss different things that make your toddler happy, such as a favorite blanket, teddy bear, etc. Discuss how your toddler is "thankful" for these things that make them happy. What are their favorite things? People? Animals? You can make a list together and compare them. You can also make a "what I am thankful for" collage with pictures of your toddler's favorite things.

\* Make some "thank you" notes for the people in your toddler's life and write on them what your toddler is thankful to them for.

\*You can create a "thankful" box for the whole family and everyone can add to it through the whole year. Then on a special day, such as Thanksgiving, you can pull out these notes and share them with everyone. One website also suggested using these pieces of paper to then make a "thankful" chain for decoration.
