### Some Art Activities:

\* Let your toddler have some crayons and paper time to see what fun things they can come up with. If you want to, you can also let them play with finger-paints, but you may want to put some plastic down first or let your toddler use sponges to make the designs or shapes. While they are coloring or painting, discuss colors with them. You can also guide their hand to draw shapes and discuss them.
