

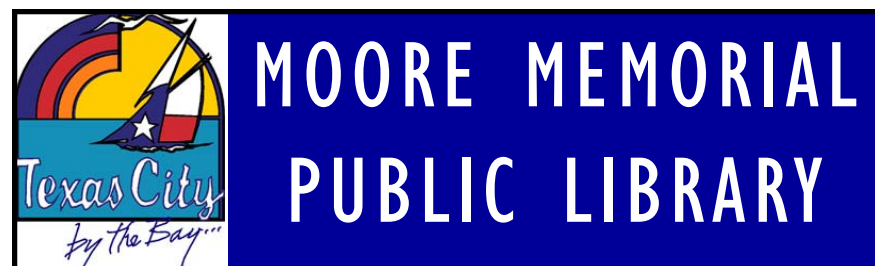
Moore Memorial Public Library was started in 1927 by the Texas City Civic Club and offers library cards and services free of charge to all Texas residents. These services include:
