The program is open Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. (closed on city holidays). Activities include lunch, dominoes, bingo, arts and crafts, board games, movies with popcorn, reading, and celebrations for special occasions and holidays. "Our staff is eager to serve our senior citizens by listening to their concerns, encouraging positive thinking, and promoting self-esteem. By interacting in all activities, we focus on the needs of the entire group as well as the needs of each of our seniors."

Seniors 60 and over must fill out an application to register to be eligible for the lunch program and are also encouraged to reserve lunch 24 hours in advance.

Lowry Center (Senior Fitness)

The Lowry Center offers a membership to senior citizens at a reduced rate. Programs offered include:

"Slow & Easy" aerobics for active seniors, 8-8:30 a.m., Monday through Friday

"At Your Own Pace" indoor daily walking from 6-9 a.m. Monday through Friday

"Senior Citizen Water Aerobics," a low-impact water exercise class for seniors held on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 10-11 a.m. and Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5-6 p.m.

Transportation Services

"Daily transportation is provided to and from the center to persons 55 years or older who live in Texas City, West Texas City, and La Marque who participate in the Nessler Program. It is the passenger's responsibility to notify the driver or call the main number at (409) 643-5877 by no later than 8 a.m. the morning of pickup. Transportation is also provided locally for shopping, errands, doctor's appointments, special outings, day trips, etc."

You can also call that number for any questions you may have about any of these programs.

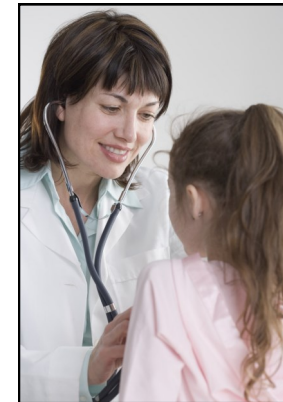

TEEN HEALTH CENTERS

Anyone through age 21 can visit these clinics, but if you are under 18, you need a consent form signed by a parent or guardian. “Our Medical Services include: examination, diagnosis & treatment of both acute & chronic illness, immunizations, well child exams, well woman exams, treatment of minor injuries, physical exams (including work and sports). Our Mental Health Services include care for: depression, school problems (LD & ADHD), family problems, anxiety, grief counseling, and stress management. Appointments are preferred.”
