YP FIC ROWELL**Rainbow Rowell**Fangirl

Feeling cast off when her best friend outgrows their shared love for a favorite celebrity, Cath, a dedicated fan-fiction writer, struggles to survive on her own in her first year of college while avoiding a surly roommate, bonding with a handsome classmate who only wants to talk about words, and worrying about her fragile father.

SF RYAN**Anthony Ryan**Blood Song: A Raven's Shadow Novel

Left by his father with the Brothers of the Sixth Order to train as a defender of the Faith and of the Realm, ten-year-old Vaelin Al Sorna grows up hating his father for abandoning him. Developing into a natural leader, Vaelin becomes increasingly involved in the politics and practice of war. He soon finds, though, that he is the target of assassination attempts by unknown enemies.

FIC SCHUYLER**Nina Schuyler**The Translator

After an accident, renowned translator Hanne Schubert loses the ability to speak anything but Japanese. Feeling isolated in an English speaking world, she leaves for a conference in Japan. When her notorious, hilarious, volatile, talented, troubled, and agoraphobic mother goes missing, teenage Bee begins a trip that takes her to the ends of the earth to find her.

FIC SIMSION**Graeme Simsion**The Rosie Project LP

Don Tillman, a professor of genetics, sets up a project designed to find him the perfect wife. Then he meets Rosie, who is everything he's not looking for in a wife, but she ends up his friend as he helps her try and find her biological father.

FIC TARTELLI**Abigail Tarttelin**Golden Boy

FIC BAKERLongbourn  **Jo Baker**

A look behind-the-scenes of Jane Austen's *Pride and Prejudice*, into the world of the servants of the Bennet household.

FIC BARRYLexicon LP**Max Barry**

There is an organization that teaches "poets" to make words into weapons for unknown purposes. Emily Ruff excels in their world, until committing a huge error, falling in love. Years later, Wil Parke is dealing with the fall out that their connected lives bring about.

FIC CONKLINThe House Girl**Tara Conklin**

A novel of love, family, and justice follows Lina Sparrow, an ambitious first-year associate in a Manhattan law firm, as she searches for the "perfect plaintiff" to lead a historic class-action lawsuit worth trillions of dollars in reparations for descendants of American slaves.

FIC FOWLERZ: A Novel of Zelda Fitzgerald **Therese Fowler**

Scott and Zelda Fitzgerald follows their union in defiance of her father's opposition and her abandonment of the provincial finery of her upbringing in favor of a scandalous flapper identity that gains her entry into the literary party scenes of New York, Paris and the French Riviera.

SF GAIMANThe Ocean at the End of the Lane LP  **Neil Gaiman**

Coming home where he grew up as a child, the narrator remembers the time forty years ago and the farm of Lettie Hempstock, a girl he hasn't thought about for a long time. When they were children, a force was unleashed that threatened both their lives, and she swore to protect him, not matter what.

MYS GALBRAITThe Cuckoo's Calling **Robert Galbraith**

Cormoran Strike is barely scraping by as private detective. Then a golden opportunity falls into his lap.

Supermodel Lula Landry, "The Cuckoo," allegedly jumped to her death a few months before, but her brother knows she would never commit suicide and wants Strike to prove it.

FIC HOSSEINIAnd the Mountains Echoed LP  **Khaled Hosseini**

As Agnes's death looms, however, the farmer's wife and daughters learn there is another side to the sensational story they've heard.

MYS LEMAITREAlex**Pierre Lemaître**

Alex Prevost is resourceful, tough, and no ordinary victim of kidnapping, but her time is running out. Commandant Camille Verhoeven and his detectives have nothing to go on. All they know is that a girl was snatched off the streets of Paris and bundled into a white van. The enigma that is the fate of Alex will keep Verhoeven guessing until the bitter, bitter end. Brigid Quinn takes an early retirement from hunting sexual predators for the FBI. Then a man named

Floyd Lynch confesses to the murder of her young protégée, Jessica, and offers to lead the cops to Jessica's body in return for a plea bargain. The new agent on the case, Laura Coleman, thinks the confession is fake, and Brigid finds she cannot walk away, no matter the cost.

FIC MCVEIGHThe Fever Tree**Jennifer McVeigh**

South Africa, 1880. Frances Irvine, destitute after her father's death, is forced to abandon wealth and privilege in London and immigrate to the Cape. There she becomes entangled with the dark heart of the diamond mines and two men. Torn between passion and integrity, she makes a choice that has devastating consequences.

FIC MEYERThe Son LP **Philipp Meyer**

Comanche Indian captive Eli McCullough must carve a place for himself in a world in which he does not fully belong. A journey of adventure, tragedy, hardship, grit, and luck that continues through future generations in Texas.

MYS MORRELLMurder as a Fine Art**David Morrell**

Thomas De Quincey is the major suspect in a series of murders. The blueprint for the killings seems to be his essay "On Murder Considered as One of the Fine Arts."
