

2018 CHILDREN'S SUMMER READING PROGRAM



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Summer Reading Clubs (Up to age 12)

Growing Readers (Pink Reading Log):

Children who need help reading can listen to 40 books to receive a prize.

Readers (Green Reading Log) :

Children who are able to read on their own can read 10 hours or 40 books to receive a prize.

How it works : For every completed reading log turned in each child will get a book prize. There is no limit to the number of logs you can turn in so the more you read the more books you can earn. The last day to turn in all logs is Saturday August 4, 2018.

CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 8 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE PERSON 14 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AT ALL TIMES IN THE CHILDREN'S DEPARTMENT.

We have a year-round early literacy program called 1000 Books Before Kindergarten. See Children's Department staff for more details and to sign up. Books read over the summer can be used for 1000 book. A separate log will need to be filled for both programs.

Summer Reading Club Information -FAQ's

What is the purpose of the Summer Reading Club?

The goal is to maintain or improve reading skills and knowledge for all ages, particularly children. It is especially important for children to practice their reading skills when out of school for the summer break. If kids read and keep their mind active during the summer, they will be better prepared for school in the fall.

How do we start the reading club?

No registration or sign up is required, simply stop by & pick up a log in the library or print one out from the library's website! Reading logs will be available starting June 4, 2018, the kick-off date for the summer reading club 2018. All logs must be turned in by August 4, 2018.

Do programs cost money?

No, all programs are free with no tickets or registration required. All programs last about an hour except Lego Problem Solving which lasts about an hour and a half. To attend a program, just come to the library the day of the program. We will open the meeting room door about 10 minutes before the program begins. Please do not be late. After the program starts, no one will be admitted. Space is limited.

What else do I need to know about attending children's programs?

Parents of children age 6 and older are encouraged to browse the library or use the computer while their child is in the program. Due to space limitations, day care or camp groups are normally not allowed. We ask that people not come and go from the meeting room during a program, as it creates a distraction for others. Please remember to turn off or silence cell phones. No pictures or videos may be taken during programs due to privacy issues.

Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA)

Moore Memorial Public Library will make reasonable accommodations for people with disabilities interested in using the library and attending programs. Please give advance notice for special accommodations.

No tickets required to attend any program. Programs will be held in the Walter Holland Meeting Room by the Circulation Desk. Door opens about 10 minutes before the program begins and will remain open until the start of the program. Parents of children age 6 and older are encouraged to browse the library or use the computer while their child is in the program. After the program starts, no one will be admitted. Space is limited. Day care or camp groups are normally not allowed.
